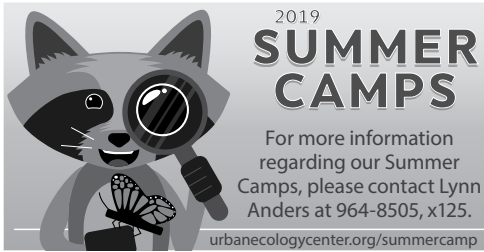

How to Register

Online

Visit urbanecologycenter.org/summercamp to sign your kids up for camp! Spaces are limited.

- Online registrations receive priority enrollment.
- You will need an email address and your child's current health information to complete registration.
- If a camp session is full, you can add your child to the waiting list or choose a different session.
- Any reference to your child's grade is referring to the grade completed by June 2019.
- You will be asked to create an account during the registration process through ActiveNetwork. This user account allows you to save registration receipts, check out faster and save time when signing up for multiple camp sessions.
