Hi Everyone,

We had a wonderful time today at UEC, we are so fortunate to be one of their NEEP partners. I am including information in the updates section below to sign up for their camps this summer, specifically the Pathfinders camp which was designed for our school and our students. The two camp leaders, Tory Bahe and Laurel Cutright are the two wonderful ladies we have as leaders on all of our trips. I trust both Tory and Laurel, completely. They know your child almost as well as we do. Pathfinders camp is open to ALL St. Coletta student and is listed in the below link and it says it is located at Riverside Park. The leaders will still be Tory and Laurel. The Pathfinders camp is July 30-August 3rd and there are scholarships available. I know many families go for free or for just \$10 or \$20 for the whole week. Let me know if you have any questions. The link is below for all the UEC camps, you can ignore the grade level and the age limits. All camps are open to our students no matter what the grade.

Update from Urban Ecology:

Summer camp registration is OPEN! We are super excited about our camps this year. They will be running from June 25<sup>th</sup>-Aug. 25<sup>th</sup> at all 3 of our branches. We have a couple camps starting the week of June 18<sup>th</sup>. I've attached English and Spanish copies of our brochures for you to share with your families. The Spanish version only provides information about our camps running at our Menomonee Valley branch. Students who attend trips this spring will also get bookmarks with the basic registration information. Please let me know if I can drop off posters and some brochures to your offices.

As NEEP partners, your students can easily qualify for scholarship spots. About 40% of our 890 spots are reserved for families in need of scholarships. These scholarships are determined using a sliding fee scale based on the 2017 Federal Poverty Guidelines. You can direct families to complete the necessary information (2016 or 2017 annual income & number of children supported by that income) on the registration page within the brochure OR by going to the link below and completing the information on the "Scholarship" tab. You can also have families contact me if they need help with this. We can also visit during spring open houses to assist with summer camp registration so don't hesitate to call me!
