Good news... the vaccine to help fight the CoVid 19 virus is now available to all who are 16 years old and older! If you are planning to receive the shot, now's your chance. On the whole, just over 41% of eligible adults in the US have now been vaccinated. That is good news for sure. There is still a long way to go as the goal is to get to 80% or more. Vaccination appointments are available through the Health Department's scheduling portal and vaccine information hub at [milwaukee.gov/covidvax](http://milwaukee.gov/covidvax). People without internet access can schedule appointments by calling 414-286-6800. It is still important to follow safety guidelines like masking and staying physically distant from people who are not in your immediate 'bubble'. All of these precautions are still necessary because of the new variants of the virus that continue to spread throughout the United States and the world. And, there is evidence that the new variants are beginning to affect younger individuals. We all hope and pray that we will make continuing progress in defeating this virus.
